

## Practical information for participants in sessions and panels

**For those of you that had your individual abstracts accepted**, we have put you together in sessions. Please note the following:

We have set aside 20 minutes for each individual paper (15 minutes for the presentation as such, and 5 minutes for open discussion). If that is obeyed, there will be space for a general discussion at the end of the time allocated. It is very important that the scheduled time frames are respected, especially if there is a new item of the programme directly afterwards, or if your session ends at 16.45, since the conference venue has to be empty by 17.00.

Please be at your allocated spot at the latest 10 minutes before the start of the session. If you have a powerpoint presentation, it can be transferred to the computer at that time. You may also then decide in which order you present during the session.

For those of you that sent in ready-made panels or sessions, you can freely organise the event within your allocated time. But, of course, you must still end your session on schedule at the latest.

Please remember that this is a conference with a wide audience of researchers, activists and other people generally interested in politics and Marxist theory. Therefore, try as much as you can to adapt your presentation to that context.
